We take the protection of your personal data seriously and want you to feel secure while browsing through our website. However, we are not responsible for external links to third-party content despite the careful control of the content.

Collection and processing of personal data

In general, you can visit the Thonet GmbH website without providing any personal data. We only collect personal data if, for example, you submit personal information within the framework of registration for the newsletter, a survey, or an inquiry via the contact form. Each access to our homepage and each access of a file placed on the homepage is recorded. The storage of such data is for internal system-relevant purposes and web statistics. The following items are recorded: name of the accessed file, date and time of access, quantity of transferred data, report about successful access, web browser and requesting domain. In addition, the IP addresses of the requesting computers are recorded. By using this website you agree with the processing of the data collected about you in the above way and with the above-mentioned purposes.

Use and forwarding of personal data and purpose limitation

Personal data acquired within the framework of the THONET GmbH Internet direct services is collected, processed, and used according to the applicable regulations for the protection of personal data and only for the purpose of contract processing and the preservation of legitimate internal business interests with regard to the processing of orders from our customers and interested people.

Right of access and public register of processing information

Upon request, we will inform you in writing in compliance with the applicable law whether and what personal data about you is stored on our end. In our public register of processing information we have compiled the information in compliance with §4e BDSG.

Cookies

So-called cookies are used at certain locations on our pages. A cookie is a little text file that is stored from a website onto your hard disk. Cookies do not harm your PC or contain viruses. The cookies on our Internet pages do not collect any personal data whatsoever. We use the information contained in cookies to make it easier for you to use our pages and to tailor them to your requirements. You can of course view our website without cookies. If you do not want cookies to be stored on your PC, you can disable the relevant option in the system settings of your browser. You can delete

stored cookies in the system settings of your browser at any time. However, if you do not accept cookies, this may restrict the functions of our offers.

How we use cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

We use traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about web page traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to customer needs. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system.

Overall, cookies help us provide you with a better website, by enabling us to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us. You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website.

Security

Thonet GmbH utilizes technological and organizational security measures in order to protect the data you provide to THONET GmbH from arbitrary or intentional manipulations, loss, destruction or access by unauthorized persons. Our security measures are continuously improved in accordance with technological developments.

Legal venue
